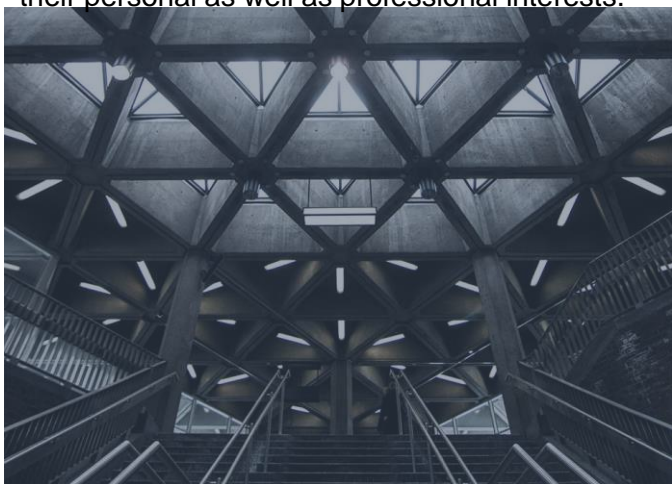


DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC POLICY (DPP) - MAHE BENGALURU

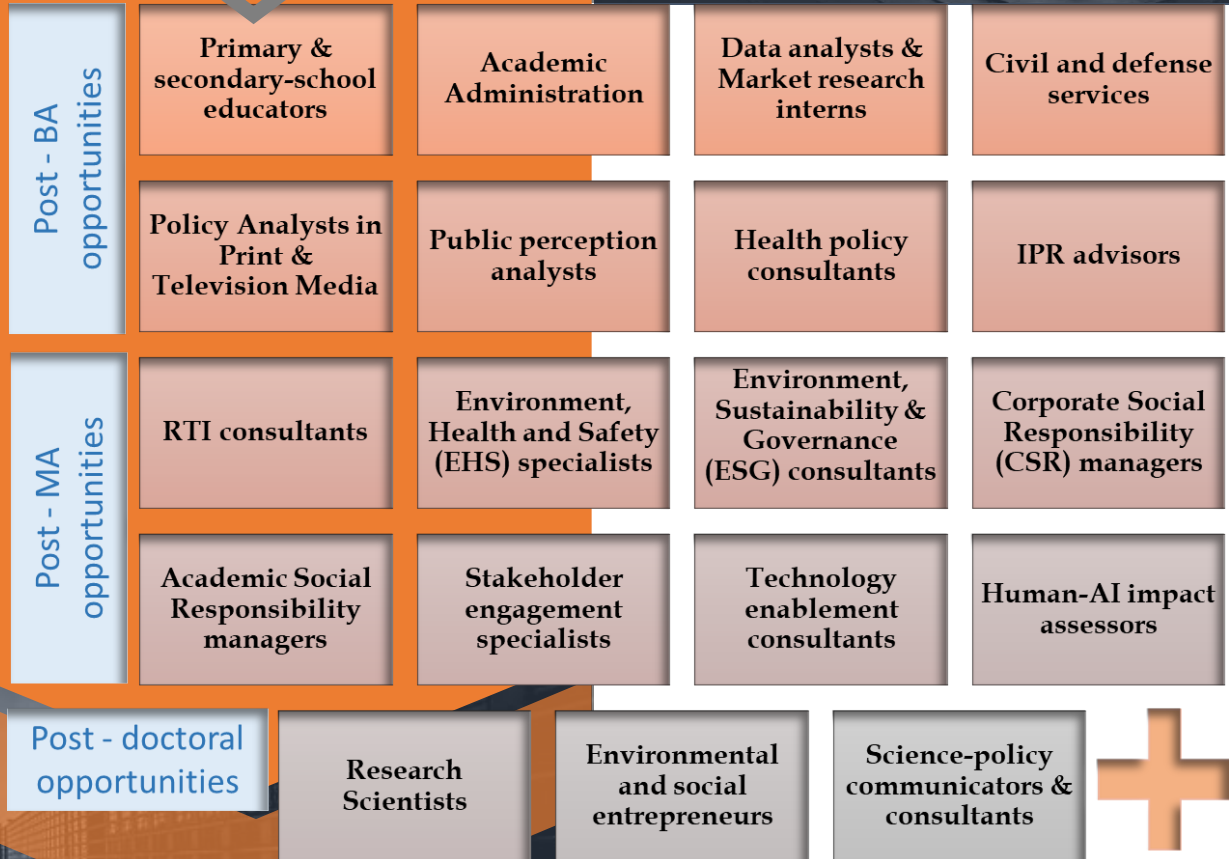
