On behalf of the Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG<sup>®</sup>) and its foundation, the Foundation for Advancement of International Medical Education and Research (FAIMER<sup>®</sup>), I wish to thank you for your completion and return of FAIMER's Medical School Profile survey. The information you provided will be used by FAIMER to enhance and expand its data resources on the world's medical education programs.

Enclosed you will find aggregate United States Medical Licensing Examination<sup>®</sup> (USMLE<sup>®</sup>) performance reports for Step 1, Step 2 Clinical Knowledge (CK), and Step 2 Clinical Skills (CS). For each exam, your medical school is receiving a one-year, multiple-year, or country-level report. The particular report you receive is determined by the number of first-time and repeat attempts by students and graduates of your institution during the reporting period. If students/graduates of your school had five or more first-time attempts or five or more repeat attempts in 2017, you will receive a report of aggregate performance for that year. Otherwise, you will receive a report of scores aggregated over the five-year period from 2013 to 2017, provided a sufficient number of your students/graduates took the exam during that period. If there were an insufficient number of examinees from your school during the five-year period, you will receive a report of aggregate performance for your country.

This report compares the performance of examinees from your medical school with the performance of examinees from all medical schools outside the United States and Canada (international medical graduates [IMGs]) taking Step 2 CS of the United States Medical Licensing Examination (USMLE) for the first time in the reporting period listed above. The performance of examinees who repeated the examination during this reporting period is also summarized below. Please note that in order to pass Step 2 CS (Total Test), it is necessary to pass all three subcomponents: Integrated Clinical Encounter (ICE), Communication and Interpersonal Skills (CIS), and Spoken English Proficiency (SEP). Information on passing examinees is provided for Step 2 CS and for each of its subcomponents. Individual examinees with multiple attempts during the reporting period may be represented in both the First Attempt and Repeat Attempt counts and may be represented multiple times in the Repeat Attempt counts. Prior attempts on the ECFMG Clinical Skills Assessment are considered when determining whether or not a Step 2 CS score is a repeat attempt.
