Manipal Tata Medical College (MTMC) has successfully completed ERUDITE: National Conference for Undergraduate Medical Students, a two-day event held from September 21 to 22 at the MTMC premises. This conference was part of the celebration of 2024 as the MAHE Year of Research Excellence in the region.

ERUDITE marked a significant step in advancing medical research, organized by the Student Research Forum under the auspices of the UG Research Vertical. The event
