Financial inclusion is a process of ensuring access to formal financial system by individuals and firms at a reasonable cost. The goals of financial inclusion in a resource constrained Indian economy can be achieved only through innovation in financial sector. Soft copy of the complete paper not exceeding 5000 words or 12 pages including figures should be submitted. All the references used in the paper should be alphabetically listed using APA 6 style.
